Co left Ober-Ingelheim by motor at 0715 and arrived at 0800 where orders to cross the Rhein River were awaited. The 1st elements of the Co boarded Naval LCI's at 1300 and debarked approx 1 1/2 miles N. of Kastel. Co then marched 6 miles to Igstadt where the attack started. Co pressed forward 2 miles to Medenbach clearing the town and taking many prisoners. Co continued to move forward, going 2 miles to Auringen and again clearing the town, then moving on to Nierdenhausen, a distance of 5 miles. At the present time the Co is dug in near the Autoban Highway on high ground approx 2500 yds NE of Nierdenhausen. During this advance the Co took 300 EM and 22 O's as prisoners.
