On an order moved fr Pont-A-Mousson at 0200 in attack formation. Bn crossed Baillie River with Co "B" landing and crossing Hill 237, the first objective, at 1000. Bn continued to push on toward Namcourt, where it ran into heavy enemy resistance. Bn remained near Namcourt for the night, while Co "B" moved fr town of Port Sur Baillie to location 3 miles N of Ely. Left old OP at 1900 arrived at new OP at 20.00 a distance of 3 miles. Total distance travelled fr Pont-A-Mousson 10 miles. 1 Off & 2 EM KIA; 1 Off & 40 EM MIA; 6 Off & 39 EM wounded.

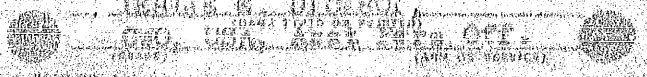

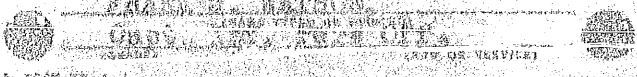
