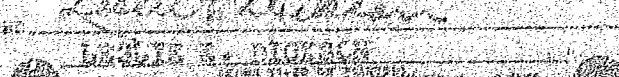
From 0500 to 0600 Friendly artillery laid barrage. At 0600 1st Bn started attack heading east. 1st Bn this regt. to right and elements of 5th Inf Bn on left. 1st Bn attacking also. This Bn on extreme left of XII Corps. At 0600 L Co crossed the Gwillo river in a swift hour 1/2 mile NE of Navvillo. I Co followed L and K Co crossed in boats 1/2 mile beyond high ground east of the river with little resistance and pushed on. At 1215 2nd Bn this regt followed up and veered to the left to protect our left flank. This Bn moved eastward under continuous resistance arriving at 2000 at new positions. Casualties: 1 Off WIA 38 EW WIA, 1 Off WIA and 39 EW WIA. Morale fair. Weather rain with extreme cold. An located at 88.3-30.4 1/50,000 Map of Normandy.

On east patrol into enemy to clear out resistance. At 1615 Bn moved 2 miles to east and dug in at 96.2-41.9 and remained in defensive position for the night. The casualties for past 3 days have been heavy, many of them due to sickness. Casualties 3 BN KIA, 4 KIA, 49 BN wounded and 1 CSM wounded. Weather: rain at freezing temperature.

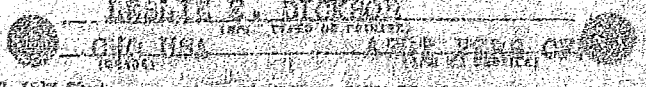

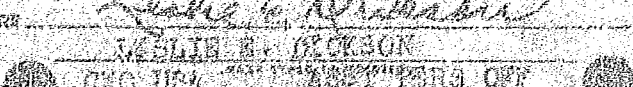

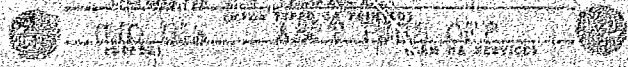
