This Bn moved by foot from Montauville, France at 2100 11 Sept 44 to assembly area Northwest 1 1/2 miles from Dieulouard, France prep to attacking and crossing Moselle River. Attack jumped off at 0400 with Company I and Company K abreast and Company L in reserve. At 0400 Artillery laid down barrage of 1 hour duration and with continuous support, including 48 Machine Guns supplied by 305th Engineers, this Bn crossed the river, seized the Bn objective, High Grounds Southeast of the river, thus forming a bridgehead for balance of CT 317 and JT 318. Now dug in awaiting possible counter-attack by the enemy. Casualties undetermined but believed to be moderate.
