- 1-3 Crescent Tennesees - Uenal Camp Durbin - Sup for Land A. Manensse
- 4 Crescent Tennesees - Situation became tactical 1800. Beginning of Phase # 2, 2nd Army movements
- 5 Crescent Tennesees - CT move to concealed assembly area 2 1/2 mi. N. of Murphysboro
- 6 Vicinity Murphysboro - CT (less 1st Bn on Coyse reserves) moved from assembly area at 1600 heading North towards Spavens. Weather good, roads excellent. March excellent. Made contact w/ 2nd force 1 mi S. Jacobson 1800
- 7 Tascoccy, Tenn. CT held up by strong forces vic. Tascoccy during night, proceeded towards Waltersville 0300. Contacted Red Airborne Unit N of Hwy 10 at 0130. Airborne troops attached at 0900 in superior numbers. In fence preceded winter defense by noon. Weather excellent 13-20. Weather light roads dry & dusty but good. March good. Condition of troops tired & hungry.
