- 1-3 VISUAL FIELD WITH GARRISON TRAINING. 35 MILES SOUTH OF MURFREESBORO, (ROSCOE) TENN.  
 4 LEFT CAMP TO NEW. S. ORIENTED DIVOVAR. AREA TO START IN ARMY MARCHES, 6 MILES SOUTH EAST. A.C.  
 MURFREESBORO, TENN. MARCH, 9 MILES. MORALE GOOD. WEATHER VERY HOT.  
 5 MOVED OUT ON SAINESVILLE TO TAKE HIGH GROUND TO MOVE ENEMY TROOPS BACK. MARCH 10 MILES, MORALE  
 EXCELLENT, WEATHER HOT.
