- 1-4 Camp Forest, Tenn. Usual Camp duties.
- 5-6 Camp Forest Tenn. Left Camp Forest 6:00 hrs enroute to Kellogg, Tenn. to engage w/ 1st Army maneuvers. Arrived 1 1/2 miles north of Kellogg, Tenn. at 0410 hrs. Distance traveled by Motor transportation 133 miles. Remained in bivouac area until 1145 hrs. then moved to area near Sulston Tenn. Distance covered by Motor 490 mi. About 1930 hrs. Weather hot
- 7 Sulston Tenn. Remained in bivouac area + engaged in various skirmishes with Paratroopers. Captured approximately 35. Weather hot. Condition + morale of troops excellent.
- 8 Sulston Tenn. Engaged paratroopers in bivouac area. 15 captured. Weather hot. Condition + morale of troops excellent.
- 9-10 Sulston Tenn. Engaged large force of paratroopers. Captured approximately 125, moved to Madison Tenn. by Motor at 0105, arriving 0400. Engaged paratrooper force at day. Condition hot at 1200 hrs. Moved to bivouac area east of Madison at 1230 hrs. Moved by Motor from Madison

- 9-10 Peace Hill area near Hartsville in Peace Hill area. Distance traveled approximately 52 miles since departure from Madison 1900. Arrived at Brown's 7:15. Weather: Hot. Conditions: morale of troops excellent.
- 11-17 Peace Hill area near Hartsville. Threat from tactical action.
- 13 Peace Hill area near Hartsville. Problem for some tactical at 0600. Set up personal CP defense + plant unit tank platoon for the 1st Security.
- 14 Peace Hill area near Hartsville. Remained in same position as previous days. At approximately 1300, 40 or 45 C47's passed over CP. From time dangling from planes, troops evidently landed to our rear. Engaged in skirmishes with our own troops captured 12.
- 15 Peace Hill area near Hartsville. Remained in CP thru entire day. No action.
- 16 Peace Hill area near Hartsville. Remained in CP thru entire day. 7 prisoners fed. No other action. Plane landed at 1330 hrs.

23. Camp Forest, Tenn. Left CP at 1030 hrs enroute by motor to Brown's area near Murfreesboro, Tenn. Airborne destination & 2700 hrs distance traveled approximately 36 miles. Weather warm. Conditions - morale of troops, excellent.
24. Present, Tenn (6 mi. S of Murfreesboro). Set up all CP installations etc. in preparation for 10 day Brown's.
