I HAVE ENCLOSED A COPY OF A ROSTER BOOKLET THEY GAVE US AFTER THE WAR. YOUR GRANDDAD, S
NAME IS NOT IN THERE BUT I KNOW THEY MADE SOME MISTAKES IN IT.

I REJOINED THE CO. IN APRIL AND BY THEN THE GERMANS WERE PRETTY ${\bf M}$ UCH ON THE RUN AND

THERE WAS NOT A WHOLE LOT OF FIGHTING. I KNOW THERE WERE SOME MIS TAKES IN THE BOOKLET

AS I JOINED THE CO. IN 1945. THEY HAD ME LISTED AS 1944.

PROBABLY THE ONLY OTHER PIECE OF INFORMATION I MIGHT HAVE IS A MAP SHOWING THE 80TH PATH THROUGH EUROPE WHICH IS ABOUT 31 X 22 IN.

I HOPE I HAVE BEEN OF SOME HELP.
