### CALL TO THE REUNION

#### To all 80th Division Veterans, Families, Descendants, Researchers and Friends,

It is a great pleasure to extend an invitation to attend the 104<sup>th</sup> reunion of the 80th Division Veterans Association to be held in Richmond, VA on **August 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11th, 2024**. We have selected the Doubletree by Hilton Richmond Midlothian located at 1021 Koger Center Blvd Richmond, VA 23235 as our host hotel. Reservations should be made prior to **July 16th, 2024**, by calling the hotel reservation line at (800) 222-8733 or by using the provided link on the 80<sup>th</sup> website or Facebook page or through the Hilton app (group code 91V). **NOTE:** Please book early and identify yourself as being with the 80th Division Veterans Association to get the special room block rate of \$125 + tax. Wi-Fi and parking are complimentary. Please specify your room type (handicap accessible if desired, pet friendly).

We have condensed our reunion to 3 days this year and the outings will now be left to the individual. There are numerous attractions in Richmond and the surrounding areas to choose from.

Our speakers will feature James Triesler, Director of Education - Virginia War Memorial, Megan Farenczy, Director of Education-Virginia Holocaust Museum, Andy Adkins, 80<sup>th</sup> division historian for WWII, presenting on methods to research military veterans, Leon Reed presenting on the 80<sup>th</sup> Division's advance across Europe in WWII and training at multiple camps based upon letters written by Frank Lembo, Dr. Lee Anthony, 80<sup>th</sup> division historian of WWI, presenting on significant battles fought by the 80<sup>th</sup> in WWI. MG (R) John McLaren, our current national commander, will be presenting on the 80<sup>th</sup> division in Iraq 2005-2006. We also have invitations out to several European guest speakers so stay tuned for more information to come. **Note:** Saturday Night's event will be a Formal Dress Evening with the 80th Division Training Command based in Richmond VA.

2024 marks the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary for many of the events during World War II. The 80<sup>th</sup> was baptised by fire at Argentan, then travelled the 600+ mile joyride across France after German resistance in Normandy collapsed. Its first contested river crossing at the Moselle, in mid-September, foreshadowed three months of bitter, yard-by-yard combat across the province of Lorraine. Ready to cross into Germany in mid-December, the Blue Ridgers instead galloped 150 miles northward to close off the German "Bulge" and played pivotal roles in the liberation of Ettelbruck, Bastogne, and other centers. In 1945, the division faced its most challenging river crossing at the Sauer, galloped into the interior of Germany, and made contact with the Russians at Liezen, Austria, on VE Day. The Blue Ridgers liberated Buchenwald and Ebensee, accepted the surrender of the entire German Sixth Army, and fired the last shot in the ETO.

We know you look forward to the reunions and realize some cannot attend in person, so we are trying something new by adding a virtual option this year. You will have access to the lectures and the ability to interact with the speakers. There are various activities planned so please join us to make this reunion one to remember. See you in August!
